- **10/23/2022 07:41 PM, Domestic Dispute (Clark Street):** Officers responded to Clark Street on a report of a domestic dispute. One of the parties involved in the dispute had a warrant for their arrest. He was taken into custody and processed.
- **10/26/2022 07:56 AM, Burglary to Auto (Kipp Street):** Owner of a vehicle left his vehicle unlocked during the overnight hours. Several items were stolen including credit cards that were used at nearby merchants. Incident is currently under investigation.
- **10/27/2022 06:30 PM, Theft of Catalytic Converter (Tracy Place):** Victim reported that the catalytic converter from his vehicle had been removed during the overnight hours. Incident is currently under investigation
- **10/27/2022 03:50 PM, Theft of Motor Vehicle (Berkshire Place):** Owner parked his vehicle on Berkshire Place on 10/26/2022. When he returned to retrieve his vehicle, he was unable to locate it. Incident is currently under investigation.
- **10/28/2022 05:00 PM, Burglary to Auto (Summit Avenue):** Victim reported that her vehicle was broken into and several items were stolen from inside of the vehicle. The incident possibly happened during the overnight hours. Incident is currently under investigation.
- **10/27/2022 07:20 PM, Attempted Motor vehicle theft (Hudson Street):** Complainant observed two suspects attempting to break into a vehicle. The suspects were scared off by the complainant. They fled in a vehicle prior to police arriving. Incident is currently under investigation.
- **10/28/2022 11:47 AM, Robbery (West Franklin Street):** Victim reported that she was selling sneakers to the suspect. The meeting point was in the parking area of Columbus Park. The suspect brandished a handgun and a knife. Suspect took the sneaker and left in her vehicle. An investigation was conducted and the suspect was located and arrested. Complaints were signed against the suspect.
