Weekly Police Blotter

11/13/22-11/19/22

- **11/13/2022 Criminal Mischief, 03:19 PM (Main Street):** Officers responded to a parking garage on Main Street where it was reported by a victim that their car had been damaged. Windows were shattered and the car was vandalized with spray paint.
- **11/14/2022 Theft of Catalytic Converter, 09:18 AM (Washington Avenue):** Complainant reported that his vehicle was parked on Washington Avenue and the catalytic converter was stolen during the overnight hours.
- **11/14/2022 Possession of a Weapon, 23:01 (Newman Street):** Officers responded to Newman Street on the report of unknown parties knocking on resident's doors. Two parties were located. One of the parties was in possession of an illegal knife and was arrested and charged.
- **11/15/2022 Burglary to Auto, 01:35 PM (Henry Place):** Victim reported that he parked his vehicle on Henry Place. When he returned to his vehicle, he discovered that the glove compartment was open. The incident is under investigation.
- **11/17/2022 Attempted Theft, 08:51 AM (River Street):** Officers responded to a report of suspicious parties in the lot of a car dealership. They found a party wearing a ski mask and camouflage clothing. After an investigation, the party was arrested and complaints were signed.
- **11/17/2022 Arrest of Murder Suspects (Essex Street):** Three men were arrested and charged with first-degree murder, conspiracy, stalking and illegal weapons possession, among other offenses, for plotting and carrying out the murder of a 28-year-old victim on 11/12/2022. The arrests are the result of an investigation conducted by the Hackensack Police Department and the Bergen County Prosecutor's Office. The initial report on 11/12/2022 was a report of shots fired in the area of Essex Street. Responding officers found one male victim who sustained a non-life-threatening gunshot wound. A second victim was transported to Hackensack University Medical Center, where he was pronounced deceased from a gunshot wound.
