12/04/22-12/10/22

- **12/04/2022 Stolen Auto, 07:15 AM (Anderson Street):** Victim reported that she went inside of a restaurant on Anderson Street and left her vehicle running in the parking lot to warm up. She left her keys in the vehicle and left the vehicle unlocked. When she returned to her vehicle, the vehicle was gone. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **12/04/2022 Driving While Intoxicated, 10:51 PM (Hamilton Place):** Police was notified in regards to a vehicle crashing into a parked vehicle as the driver was attempting to pull into their driveway. Officers responded and located the driver. Field sobriety tests were administered and the driver was placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated.
- **12/04/2022 Warrant Arrest / Motor Vehicle Stop, 11:11PM (River Street):** While on patrol, an officer observed a temporary registration that was obstructed by a license plate frame. A motor vehicle stop was conducted. It was discovered that the temporary registration was fictitious and expired. The operator of the vehicle also had an outstanding warrant. The operator was placed under arrest and the vehicle was impounded. He was also was issued multiple motor vehicle summonses.
- **12/07/2022 Burglary to Auto, 09:35 AM (Hackensack Avenue):** The victim reported that she parked her vehicle in a parking garage outside of her home on 12/06/2022. When she returned the next day, she noticed that several items had been stolen from inside of her vehicle. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **12/08/2022 Criminal Mischief, 08:35 AM (Frederick Street):** It was reported that unknown actors had tagged a USPS mailbox with unknown illegible writing. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **12/09/2022 Burglaries to Auto (Parker Avenue):** It was reported that numerous car burglaries had occurred during the overnight hours on Parker Avenue. The burglaries are currently being investigated.
