Weekly Police Blotter

12/18/22-12/24/22

- **12/18/2022 Burglary to Auto, 02:54 PM (Charles Street):** Victim reported that early in the morning on 12/18/2022, a suspect opened her unlocked vehicle and stole some of her belongings. The incident was captured on a nearby surveillance camera. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **12/18/2022 Driving while Intoxicated 11:40 PM (Lodi Street):** Officers responded to the area of Lodi Street and South State Street on a report of a possible drunk driver. Officers on scene conducted an investigation and the driver was placed under arrest for the suspicion of driving while being impaired.
- **12/19/2022 Shoplifting 02:07 PM (Main Street):** A suspect was observed placing various items listed for sale into her shopping bag. She walked by the point of sale without paying for those items and was stopped by store security. The suspect was banned from returning to that store.
- **12/19/2022 Theft, 09: 04PM (Prospect Avenue):** The victim reports that he had an item delivered to the lobby of his building. When he went to retrieve the item, he realized it was missing. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **12/20/2022 Driving While Intoxicated / Warrant Arrest 01:13 AM (Essex Street):** An officer was dispatched to the area of Essex Street to investigate and erratic driver. He located a vehicle matching the description of the complaint. The officer conducted an investigation and arrested the driver for suspicion of driving while impaired. It was later determined that the driver had outstanding warrants out of multiple jurisdictions. The driver was arrested and charged.
- **12/22/2022 Possession of a Weapon 02:35 PM (Anderson Street):** Officers responded to a reported robbery in the area of Anderson Street. It was learned that the suspect had taken a victim's bicycle and entered a liquor store. The investigation revealed that the suspect had pulled a box cutter out and threatened the victim. The suspect was disarmed and taken into custody. The suspect was arrested and charged.
