**Weekly Police Blotter**

*2/12/23-2/18/23*

- **2/12/2023 Aggravated Assault, 10:57 PM (Prospect Avenue):** Officers responded to HUMC on a report of a nurse that had been assaulted by a patient. Upon arrival the victim explained that the suspect exited his room and approached her, then without provocation or warning struck her in the face with a closed fist. Complaints were signed.
- **2/13/2023 Aggravated Assault, 12:40 AM (Main Street):** Officers responded to a parking garage on Main Street on a dispute involving a box cutter. While attempting to diffuse a dispute between two of the victim's ex-girlfriends, the victim sustained a laceration on his left palm from a box cutter wielded by the arrestee. Complaints were signed
- **2/14/2023 Warrant Arrest, 03:35 PM (Main Street):** While on patrol, an officer was waived down on Main Street for a shoplifting which had just occurred. He gave out a description and a direction of flight. He and another officer located the suspect. The store owner responded and her merchandise was returned to her. She did not wish to pursue the matter further; however, the suspect had an outstanding warrant from Atlantic County Sheriff's Department. She was arrested on the warrant.
- **2/16/2023 Aggravated Assault, 10:35 AM (River Street):** An officer was responding to an emergency call with his lights and sirens activated. While responding, a vehicle hit his vehicle from the rear. The officer pulled onto Salem Street and was hit again in the rear of his vehicle. Believing that the other vehicle was intentionally trying to ram his vehicle, he created distance and drove further where he was able to stop. His vehicle was again hit, now at the intersection of Main / Salem. The officer approached the vehicle and ordered the driver to exit the vehicle. The driver exited the vehicle and surrendered. The driver was taken into custody without further incident.
- **2/16/2023 Warrant Arrest, 09:30 PM (Polifly Road):** An officer conducted a motor vehicle stop. During his investigation it was discovered that the operator of the vehicle had an active warrant issued by Little Ferry Municipal Court. The arrestee was taken into custody, transported to headquarters, and processed. The arrestee was issued a new court date from Little Ferry and released from custody
