Weekly Police Blotter

2/26/23-3/4/23

- **2/26/2023 Burglary Arrest, 02:08 AM (Prospect Avenue):** A suspect was observed by security at a Prospect Avenue building entering a vehicle inside their parking garage. Officers entered the garage while other responding units set a perimeter. The suspect was observed inside a vehicle, but fled upon confrontation with officers. The suspect was eventually taken into custody. In addition, the suspect's girlfriend was located in a nearby vehicle, which had stolen plates and was reported stolen itself. Both the suspect and his girlfriend were arrested and charged.
- **2/27/2023 Shoplifting, 11:48 AM (Polifly Road):** The complainant reported that the suspect left the store on Polifly Road with two Ensure Nutritional Drink packages without paying. An officer located the suspect on Essex Street where he was placed under arrest. Complaints were signed and the suspect was released on a summons.
- **2/27/2023 Theft of Catalytic Converter (Arcadia Road):** The victim reported parking her vehicle overnight on Arcadia Road. Upon returning to her vehicle, she noticed that the catalytic converter was missing. The incident is under investigation.
- **3/3/2023 Strict Liability:** Members of Hackensack Police Department's Crime Suppression Bureau executed a search warrant of a suspect's home. The suspect was identified as the person responsible for supplying a decedent with illegal narcotics which led to his death. In addition to the strict liability death, the suspect was charged with various drug possession counts for heroin and illegal prescription pills that were found in his apartment during the search warrant.
- **3/4/2023 Theft of Catalytic Converters, 06:59 AM (Myer Street):** The complainant reported that unknown suspects attempted to steal three catalytic converters. One converter was successfully stolen. The suspects were not successful with the other two vehicles. However, the attempts caused damage to the vehicles. The incident is currently under investigation.
