10/9/22-10/15/22

- **10/09/2022 04:04 PM, Aggravated Assault (Fair Street):** Dispute led to a suspect breaking a beer bottle and slashing the victim's face. Suspect also suffered an injury and was located at the hospital. Suspect was taken into custody and charged for the assault.
- **10/09/2022 11:31 PM, DWI Arrest (State Street):** Report of a Motor Vehicle Crash. Patrol officers conducted field sobriety tests and determined that the operator of the vehicle was driving intoxicated. Operator was arrested and charged with DWI.
- **10/11/2022 08:50 PM, Vehicle Burglaries (Prospect Avenue):** A suspect was observed pulling on car door handles inside of a parking garage. A local resident chased the suspect away. The incident is currently under investigation. A suspect was identified.
- **10/12/2022 11:59 AM, DWI Arrest (Central Avenue):** Report of a Motor Vehicle Crash. It was determined by patrol officers that the operator of the vehicle was under the influence of an intoxicating substance. He was arrested and charged with DWI.
- **10/12/2022 10:41 PM, City Ordinance Violation (Lodi Street):** While conducting patrol in his assigned area, a patrol officer observed a man walking in the middle of the street and yelling at his phone. During the officer's interaction with the man, the officer observed the man to have an open bottle of alcohol which he was consuming. A city ordinance violation was issued.
- **10/12/2022 10:40 PM, Vehicle Burglary (Dyatt Place):** Patrol officers responded to a report of a burglary of a vehicle. A suspect matching the description given by a witness was located in the area of Hackensack Avenue and Route 4. Positive identification was made and the suspect was arrested and charged.
