Weekly Police Blotter

10/30/22-11/05/22

- **10/30/2022 Theft of Motor Vehicle, 04:00 AM (Park Street South):** Victim reported that her vehicle was taken without her consent. With the help of nearby residents, officers were able to identify the suspect, who was located a short time later. He was arrested and complaints were signed.
- **10/30/2022 Driving while Intoxicated, 02:47 PM (First Street):** Driver of vehicle was observed to be asleep behind the wheel by responding officers. Field sobriety tests determined that the driver was under the influence of alcohol. The driver was arrested and charged with DWI.
- **10/31/2022 Burglary, 04:45 PM (Pangborn Place):** Suspect entered a residential building on Pangborn Place and stole six packages. Incident is currently under investigation.
- **11/01/2022 Motor Vehicle Crash, 05:41 AM (Green Street):** Driver of tractor trailer attempted to make a left hand turn onto Lodi Street. The trailer bottomed out while going over the tracks and caused diesel fuel to leak onto the tracks. Bergen County Haz-Mat and NJ Transit Police were notified and responded.
- **11/02/2022 Warrant Arrest, 02:27 AM (South Park Street):** Officers responded to a domestic dispute. One of the involved parties had an outstanding warrant and was arrested on scene. He was processed and released on bail.
- **11/01/2022 Theft of Motor Vehicle, 03:15 PM (Elm Avenue):** Owner reported leaving his vehicle on Elm Avenue. When he returned to his vehicle, he realized that it had been stolen. Incident is currently under investigation.
- **11/04/2022 Driving While Intoxicated, 07:12 PM (South River Street):** Officers were called to South River Street on a report of an erratic driver. They located the vehicle and the driver was placed under arrest for driving while intoxicated.
- **11/04/2022 Stolen Vehicle Arrest, 07:36 PM (River Street):** An officer conducted a motor vehicle stop of a vehicle that had a registration that was not on file. It was learned that the vehicle's VIN number was altered. The correct VIN was located and revealed that the vehicle was reported stolen out of Virginia. The driver was placed under arrest and charged.
