Responding Officers discovered that a vehicle was missing its catalytic converter. The suspect fled the area. Incident is under investigation.

As officers were enroute, the complainant reported that the vehicle fled onto route 4. A search of the area produced negative results in locating the suspect vehicle but officers found one vehicle with a catalytic converter missing. The complainant was unable to provide any further information other than a large white SUV as the suspect vehicle. Incident is under investigation.

The victim was rushed into surgery at Hackensack University Medical Center and died two hours later from his injuries. The matter is currently under investigation with the assistance of Bergen County Prosecutor's Office.
