**Weekly Police Blotter**

**11/20/22-11/26/22**

- **11/20/2022 Burglary to Auto, 06 :58 AM (Euclid Avenue):** Victim reported that he parked his vehicle in the area of Euclid and Linden Street. When he returned to his vehicle in the morning, he noticed that his vehicle had been burglarized during the overnight hours. Incident currently under investigation.
- **11/22/2022 Motor Vehicle Crash, 07:40 AM (Camden Street):** While on patrol, an officer observed a vehicle strike the southeast corner of a building on Camden Street. The driver of the vehicle stated that the crash was due to a brake failure. Hackensack Fire Department and Hackensack Building Department responded.
- **11/22/2022 Warrant Arrest, 04:39 PM (Essex Street):** An officer was investigating a suspicious vehicle near the area of Essex and Lehigh Street. During the course of the investigation, it was determined that the driver of the vehicle had an outstanding warrant for his arrest. He was arrested for the warrant.
- **11/23/2022 Driving While Intoxicated, 12:33 AM (State Street):** An officer observed a vehicle driving with a flat tire. A motor vehicle stop was conducted and it was determined that the driver was under the influence of alcohol. She was arrested and charged.
- **11/23/2022 Shoplifting, 07:21 PM (Main Street):** Officers responded to a local business where it was reported that two parties attempted to leave the store without paying for merchandise. The amount of the merchandise was over \$1,500. Both parties were arrested and charged.
- **11/23/2022 Weapon Offense, 09:10 PM (Stanley Place):** Officers responded to Stanley Place on a report of a suspicious vehicle loitering in the area. An investigation by responding officers revealed that the passengers in the vehicle were in possession of several weapons including pepper spray, a large knife, and handgun ammunition. Both passengers were arrested and charged.
- **11/25/2022 Motor Vehicle Theft, 05:18 PM (Kipp Street):** The complainant reported that he left his key fob in his vehicle which he parked in a parking garage on Kipp Street. When he returned to his vehicle, he noticed that his vehicle was stolen. The incident is currently under investigation.
