Weekly Police Blotter

11/27/22-12/03/22

- **11/27/2022 Driving While Intoxicated, 02:00 AM (Summit Avenue):** Officers responded on a motor vehicle accident involving a vehicle that was on a lawn. The driver was arrested for driving while intoxicated and the passenger refused to provide information to the responding officers and was also arrested for obstructing their investigation.
- **11/28/2022 Theft of Package, 07:02 PM (Anderson Street):** The victim reported that a package was stolen from the lobby of her building. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **11/29/2022 Theft of Catalytic Converter, 06:20 AM (Anderson Street):** The complainant reported that he parked his vehicle in front of his home on 11/28/2022 and returned in the early morning on 11/29/2022. He discovered that his catalytic converter was stolen. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **11/29/2022 Burglary to Auto/Attempted Auto Theft, 12:35 PM (State Street):** The complainant reported that he parked his vehicle on State Street on 11/28/2022. He returned to his vehicle on 11/29/2022 and discovered that his vehicle had been entered and the steering column had been broken off in an attempt to start and steal the vehicle. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **11/30/2022 Skimming Device on ATM, 05:56 PM (Summit Avenue):** A business discovered that customers were unable to use their ATM. While the ATM was being serviced, a skimming device was located on the ATM. Detective Bureau was notified and will be following up on the investigation.
- **12/01/2022 Disorderly Conduct, 09:58 PM (Prospect Avenue):** Officers responded to Prospect Avenue on the report of a party urinating next to a box truck. The party was pointed out by a complainant. When officers approached him and asked him to leave, he began to grab and push the officers on scene and created a disturbance. He was arrested and charged.
- **12/03/2022 Shoplifting, 02:33 PM (Hackensack Avenue):** A shoplifter entered a fitting room of a store and placed 13 items of clothing and accessories into her shopping bag. She then walked out of the store. The incident is currently under investigation.
