- **12/13/2022 Stolen Auto, 08:47 PM (Tracy Place):** Victim reported that he parked his vehicle overnight on Tracy Place. When he returned to his vehicle, he noticed that it was stolen. This incident is currently under investigation
- **12/13/2022 Receiving Stolen Property / Motor Vehicle Stop, 02:09 PM (Overlook Avenue):** A city detective conducted a motor vehicle stop of a vehicle due to an equipment violation. An inquiry of the vehicle's registration revealed that the vehicle's license plate had been reported stolen out of New York City. The driver of the vehicle was arrested and charged. He was also issued multiple motor vehicle summonses.

- **12/15/2022 Warrant Arrest, 12:21 AM (Euclid Avenue):** A patrol officer conducted a motor vehicle stop on Euclid Ave due to numerous motor vehicle infractions. The vehicle was unregistered. The driver had an active warrant and was placed under arrest. The vehicle was impounded.
- **12/15/2022 Burglary to Auto, 03:33 PM (Main Street):** The victim reported parking his vehicle inside a parking garage on Main Street overnight. When he returned to his vehicle, he found that his car had been rummaged through by an unknown suspect and several items were missing from his vehicle. This incident is currently under investigation.
- **12/17/2022 Warrant Arrest, 12:28 PM (Linden Street):** Officers responded to the home of a person who had been making harassing phone calls and threats. The person had a warrant for his arrest due to those phone calls and threats. He was arrested and turned over to New Milford Police Departments where the warrant originated from.
