Weekly Police Blotter

1/22/23-1/28/23

- **1/22/2023 Motor Vehicle Theft, 09:09 PM (Prospect Avenue):** A driver was delivering food on Prospect Avenue. He left his vehicle on the street with the keys in the ignition and went to deliver the food. When he returned, his vehicle was gone. The incident is under investigation
- **1/22/2023 Theft, 11:13 AM (South River Street):** The victim parked his vehicle overnight near the area of South River Street. When he returned to his vehicle, he discovered that the catalytic converter was missing. The incident is under investigation
- **1/24/2023 Theft, 01:00 PM (South River Street):** A car dealership reported that catalytic converters from two of their vehicles were stolen during the overnight hours. The incident is under investigation.
- **1/24/2023 Shoplifting, 09:30 PM (Main Street):** A retail store on Main Street reported that three suspects entered the store and stole items valued at approximately \$700. The three suspects entered a vehicle and fled the area. The incident is under investigation.
- **1/25/2023 Burglary to Auto, 06:58 AM (Hackensack Avenue):** A victim reported that she parked her vehicle in front of a business on Hackensack Avenue. When she returned to her vehicle, she discovered that her window had been smashed and items had been stolen from her vehicle. The incident is under investigation.
- **1/25/2023 Motor Vehicle Theft, 02:08 PM (Prospect Avenue):** The victim, a food delivery driver, parked his vehicle on Prospect Avenue to make a delivery. The victim left his car running with the keys in the vehicle. Upon returning to his vehicle approximately 6 minutes later, he found his vehicle had been stolen. The victim stated the suspect was sitting next to his vehicle when he arrived and left the vehicle and the suspect was also gone upon his return to the vehicle. The incident is under investigation.
