**Weekly Police Blotter**

*2/5/23-2/11/23*

- **2/5/2023 Driving While Intoxicated / Warrant Arrest, 04:38 PM (W. Pleasantview Avenue):** An officer was advised by a customer of a business that the driver of a vehicle nearby may be ill or under the influence of some substance. A motor vehicle stop was conducted and the driver was found to have an active warrant out of Newark. The driver was arrested and transported to headquarters for processing and breath testing. He was issued several summonses.
- **2/6/2023 Investigation Arrest 09:30 PM:** On 2/1/2023 at approximately 01:22 AM, a home invasion occurred at a residence on Pangborn Place. The incident involved three suspects, two of them were positively identified. The first suspect, a juvenile was placed into juvenile custody. The second suspect turned himself in. The suspect was processed and transported to Bergen County Jail. Investigation to continue with regards to positively identifying the third suspect.
- **2/7/2023 Investigation Arrest 04:35 PM:** On 1/18/2023, a bank robbery occurred at the TD Bank Branch located at 540 River Street. During a subsequent investigation, the suspect was identified. On 02/07/2023 members of the Narcotics Bureau observed a male fitting the description of the suspect walking west on Anderson Street. After positive identification, a verbal order was given to move in and take the suspect into custody. The suspect was placed under arrest, processed, and transported to Bergen County Jail.
- **2/8/2023 Possession of C.D.S 03:03 AM (Prospect Avenue):** Hackensack University Medical Center staff located 13 wax folds of heroin and hypodermic needles on the suspect while he was in the trauma unit of the emergency room. An officer responded and took custody of the items. Complaints were signed. The suspect was released on a summons.
- **2/8/2023 Warrant Arrest 07:47 PM (Lehigh Street):** Officers responded to a group in front of a building on Lehigh Street causing a disturbance. Upon arrival, one of the officers recognized a member of the group as someone who had an active warrant. The arrestee was taken into custody and subsequently released ROR by Little Ferry Court.
- **2/10/2023 Theft of Catalytic Converter 12:30 PM (Arcadia Road):** The victim advised that they parked their vehicle in front on Arcadia Road on 02/09/2023. Upon returning they noticed that the catalytic converter was missing from the vehicle. The incident is currently under investigation.
