**Weekly Police Blotter**

*2/19/23-2/25/23*

- **2/19/2023 Theft of Catalytic Converter, 12:19 PM (Elleen Terrace):** The victim reported parking their vehicle from 02/13/2023 until 02/19/2023 on Elleen Terrace. During that time an unknown actor removed the catalytic converter from the vehicle. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **2/19/2023 Warrant Arrest, 08:00 PM (Hudson Street):** Officers responded to Hudson Street on a report of a suspicious person entering a vehicle parked on private property. The complainant stated that the person on the property was not authorized to be there. The suspect was located inside of the vehicle. It was discovered that the suspect had an active warrant issued by this jurisdiction. The suspect was arrested, processed and committed to the Bergen County Jail.
- **2/21/2023 Burglary, 03:02 AM (Atlantic Street):** Officers responded to a panic alarm at a store on Atlantic Street. They discovered the front door glass had been shattered, apparently by a large rock. The suspect stole an unknown amount of money and fled the scene. The incident is under investigation.
- **2/21/2023 C.D.S Arrest, 08:19 PM (Central Avenue):** An officer conducted a MV stop for motor vehicle violations. The suspect was found to have a contempt warrant out of Clifton. The suspect was placed under arrest for the warrant. A search incident to arrest turned up 10 wax folds of suspected heroin. The suspect posted bail for the Clifton warrant and was processed and released on a summons for the heroin possession.
- **2/24/2023 Burglary to Auto, 01:00 AM (Prospect Avenue):** Security at a high rise building on Prospect Avenue reported seeing a male enter a victim's vehicle inside a parking garage. Numerous items and cash were stolen from the vehicle. The incident is under investigation.
- **2/25/2023 Shoplifting 07:02 PM (South River Street):** The suspect entered a store and attempted to leave with \$290.52 worth of merchandise before being stopped by loss prevention. All items were recovered and the suspect fled prior to police arrival. The incident is under investigation.
