**Weekly Police Blotter**

*3/12/23-3/18/23*

- **3/12/2023 Driving While Intoxicated, 3:49 AM (Lodi Street):** Officers responded to Lodi Street on a report of a vehicle that struck multiple parked vehicles. The driver was still on scene. Field sobriety tests were conducted. The driver was deemed to be intoxicated. He was arrested and charged with DWI.
- **3/13/2023 Theft of Catalytic Converter, 12:20 PM (State Street):** The victim reported that she parked her vehicle in a parking lot on State Street. Upon returning to her vehicle, she noticed that her catalytic converter was missing. This incident is under investigation.
- **3/13/2023 Theft of Services, 6:33 PM (Polifly Road):** The complainant advised officers that the suspect filled his vehicle with \$30 worth of gasoline and then left the gas station without paying. This incident is under investigation.
- **3/15/2023 Burglary, 12:39 AM (Madison Street):** The victim stated that upon returning to his home, he entered his residence and found that his apartment had been ransacked and burglarized. This incident is under investigation.
- **3/15/2023, 4:32 AM Driving While Intoxicated (Clay Street):** Officers responded to the area of Clay Street on a report of a motor vehicle accident. Upon investigation the driver was arrested for driving while intoxicated and transported to Hackensack University Medical Center for treatment.
- **3/15/2023 Overdose, 5:27 PM (Hackensack Avenue):** Four victims were found unresponsive on the lower level of a parking garage. All victims were suffering from an apparent drug overdose after sharing an unknown narcotic. Narcan was deployed. Three victims were transported to HUMC and one was released from the scene after refusing medical attention.
- **3/18/2023 Shoplifting, 7:20 AM (Essex Street):** An unknown suspect stole five bottles of detergent from a retail store on Essex Street. This incident is under investigation.
