Weekly Police Blotter

3/19/23-3/25/23

- **3/19/2023 Robbery, 11:12 PM (Polifly Road):** The complainant, who is a gas station attendant, advised responding officers that he had been robbed by two unknown suspects. This incident is currently under investigation.
- **3/20/2023 Burglary, 6:21 AM (Banta Place):** The complainant reported that an unknown male and an unknown female burglarized his business. Proceeds were \$100.00 in United States Currency and miscellaneous food. This incident is currently under investigation.
- **3/20/2023 Motor Vehicle Accident, 11:34 AM (Essex Street):** Officers responded to Essex and Newman on a report of a motor vehicle accident involving a struck pedestrian. The pedestrian was crossing the street in the crosswalk when he was struck. The victim sustained minor non-life-threatening injuries and was transported to Hackensack University Medical Center for further treatment.
- **3/22/2023 Warrant Arrest, 01:36 AM (Main Street):** The suspect was observed on Main Street and a field contact was initiated. Two separate warrants were found and he was placed under arrest. He was released on his own recognizance for both warrants.
- **3/23/23 Driving While Intoxicated, 12:19 PM (First Street):** The arrestee was stopped in the middle of the road and accelerated, striking another vehicle. Officers responded and he appeared to be under the influence of heroin, which he self-admitted. Blood was obtained and the suspect was charged with 39:4-50.
- **3/25/2023 Shoplifting, 11:47 AM (Hackensack Avenue):** A suspect attempted to shoplift at a hardware store located on Hackensack Avenue. Loss prevention stated that the accused placed \$235.86 worth of items in a shopping cart and left the store where she was apprehended. She was processed and released on a summons.
