- 7/9/2023 Motor Vehicle Theft, 9:51 PM (Essex Street): The victim parked his vehicle on Newman Street near Lee Place on 7/8/23. When he returned to his vehicle on 7/9/23, he found that his vehicle had been stolen. The incident is under investigation.
- 7/10/2023 Shoplifting, 11:33 AM (Main Street): Officers responded to a report of shoplifting at a retail store on Main Street. It was reported that that the suspect loaded a bag with merchandise and walked past the point of sale without paying. The suspect was identified. Complaints to be signed at a later time.
- 7/11/2023 Fraud Arrest, 2:38 PM (River Street): Officers responded to River Street on a report of a party attempting to cash a fraudulent check at a local bank. Employees of the bank were able to confirm that the check was fraudulent. The alleged suspect was arrested and charged with Forgery, Receiving Stolen Property, and Theft by Deception.

- 7/15/2023 Homicide/Suicide: Hackensack Police Department and Bergen County Prosecutor's
 Office investigated a shooting that occurred at a nursing facility in Hackensack. Responding
 officers found a deceased female victim and a deceased male victim with apparent gunshot
 wounds. The investigation revealed that a 76-year-old visitor responded to the nursing home
 and killed his 73-year-old terminally ill wife. He then turned the gun on himself. The incident
 remains under investigation.
