Weekly Police Blotter

7/30/23-8/5/23

- **7/30/2023 Warrant Arrest, 08:53 AM (James Street):** On 7/30/2023, officers responded to the suspect's home on James Street to serve an active warrant stemming from a domestic violence incident that occurred earlier that morning. The suspect was arrested and transported to Bergen County Jail after processing.
- **7/30/2023 Burglary to Auto (Simons Avenue):** The victim reported that an unknown person entered her unlocked vehicle and stole several of her belongings. The victim further reported that she left her key fob inside of the vehicle. This incident is under investigation
- **7/31/2023 Shoplifting 1:54 PM (Main Street):** The suspect placed nearly \$500 in make-up in a reusable shopping bag and failed to ring all items at the self-checkout. She attempted to leave the store and was stopped by security. She was arrested, processed, and released on a summons.
- **7/31/2023 Robbery 7:40 PM (South State Street):** A juvenile victim was riding his bicycle on South State Street when a group of approximately 10-12 juveniles approached him and physically removed him from his bicycle. The incident is under investigation.
- **8/1/2023 Driving While Intoxicated 10:48 PM (Hackensack Avenue):** A driver was observed driving erratically on Hackensack Avenue by a passing motorist. He was followed into a parking lot where police responded shortly after. It was determined that the driver was driving while intoxicated. He was arrested, issued summonses, processed, and released.
- **8/3/2023 Theft 02:35 AM (Clinton Place):** Officers responded to a report of a suspicious vehicle on Clinton Place. Upon arrival, a dark vehicle with heavy tinted windows fled the area. Upon further investigation by responding officers, it was determined that a parked vehicle had all four wheels and tires removed. The vehicle was left sitting on milk crates. The incident is under further investigation.
- **8/5/2023 Theft of Motor Vehicle 05:49 AM (Polifly Road):** The victim reported that he left his vehicle running and went into a convenience store located on Polifly Road. An unknown person stole his vehicle. The incident is under investigation.
