8/20/23-8/26/23

- **8/20/2023 Criminal Mischief, 08:06 AM (Main Street):** The victim reported parking his vehicle overnight in a parking lot on Main Street. Upon returning, he observed cuts in his cloth convertible top roof. The incident is under investigation.
- **8/20/2023 Warrant Arrest, 6:22 PM (Hackensack Avenue):** Officers responded to an apartment complex on Hackensack Avenue on a report that a suspect from an earlier domestic violence incident arrived at his apartment. Upon the Officers' arrival, the suspect was placed under arrest and transported to headquarters. The suspect was processed, served with a temporary restraining order, and was transported to BCJ pending his initial appearance.
- **8/21/2023 Burglary to Auto, 7:05 PM (Pulaski Place):** The victim reported parking his van overnight on the street on Pulaski Place. The driver side door, key slot, had been punched out and an unknown party entered the vehicle. Various tool items were taken from the vehicle. The incident is under investigation.
- **8/21/2023 Warrant Arrest, 12:09 PM (Beech Street):** An officer conducted a motor vehicle stop with the suspect driving the vehicle. He was determined to have multiple warrants and was subsequently arrested. He was turned over to the Kearny Police Department.
- **8/24/2023 Burglary of Auto, 7:55 PM (Sussex Street):** The victim reported that unknown actor(s) broke into her vehicle on 08/24/2023. Actor(s) gained access to the vehicle by breaking the front driver's side window. The vehicle was parked on Sussex Street. The incident is under investigation.
- **8/26/2023 Robbery, 05:11 AM (East Camden Street):** Victims reported that they were robbed at gun point in the area of East Camden Street. The suspect's stole jewelry from the victims. The incident is under investigation.
