Weekly Police Blotter

8/6/23-8/12/23

- **8/6/2023 Warrant Arrest, 11:10 PM (Daniel Street):** Officers responded to a residence on Daniel Street for a report of an unwanted person. A victim reported that a former girlfriend was attempting to gain her attention by repeatedly banging on the windows and doors of the residence. A computer check was conducted by officers and it revealed that the suspect had an active warrant. The suspect was arrested and processed.
- **8/7/2023 Theft of Motor Vehicle, 1:36 PM (West Pleasant View Avenue):** An owner reported that his motorcycle was stolen from the parking lot of his apartment complex. The owner had his motorcycle locked and secured to a concrete post. It appeared that an unknown suspect cut the lock and stole the motorcycle. The incident is under investigation.
- **8/9/2023 Shoplifting, 4:18 PM (Hackensack Avenue):** Loss prevention at a local hardware store on Hackensack Avenue observed the suspect, via video surveillance, load a backpack with various circuit breakers and flee the store. This incident is under investigation.
- **8/9/2023 Shoplifting, 5:50 PM (Hackensack Avenue):** An employee from a retail store located inside of Riverside Square Mall reported that two suspects entered the store and stole two handbags and a clutch. The items were concealed under one of the suspect's shirts as they fled the store. This incident is under investigation.
- **8/11/2023 Driving While Intoxicated, 2:48 PM (Main Street):** Officers responded to Main Street on a report of an erratic driver. The vehicle was located and the driver was suspected to be intoxicated and was arrested for DWI.
- **8/12/2023 Burglary to Auto, 11:05 AM (Hackensack Avenue):** The victim reported that she parked her vehicle in a lot on Hackensack Avenue. When she returned to her vehicle, she noticed that her wallet was missing. The incident is under investigation.
