Weekly Police Blotter

8/27/23-9/2/23

- **8/27/2023 Theft of Auto, 10:38 PM (Oak Street):** The victim reported that he received a doorbell alert from his ring camera. He then observed a suspect stealing his vehicle. The vehicle was left unlocked with the keys inside of the vehicle. The incident is under investigation.
- **8/27/2023 Aggravated Assault, 12:00 PM (Tracy Place):** The victim reported that after a dispute with a nearby neighbor, the neighbor swung a knife at him. After further investigation, the suspect was arrested and charged with Aggravated Assault.
- **8/29/2023 Motor Vehicle Stop/Warrant Arrest, 7:25 PM (Lawrence Street):** Officers observed the defendant operating a vehicle in violation of 39:3-75.1. The officers conducted a motor vehicle stop. Defendant was arrested on multiple warrants issued by the Hackensack Municipal Court, Teaneck Municipal Court and South Hackensack Municipal Court.
- **8/29/2023 Possession of a Weapon/Warrant Arrest, 11:27 PM (Main Street):** Officers observed the defendant in violation of 39:4-34 (Pedestrian Crossing) in the area of Main Street and Atlantic Street. A pedestrian stop was conducted. Officers then observed the defendant attempting to conceal a knife in the front of his waistband. The defendant was placed under arrest for violation of 2C:39-5D (possession of a weapon). An active NCIC warrant from the Ridgefield Park Police Department for assault was also located. Defendant was charged via summons and turned over to RPPD custody.
- **8/29/2023 Motor Vehicle Stop/Warrant Arrest, 11:58 PM (Essex Street):** Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop for violation of 39:3-66.3 (maintenance of lamps) in the area of Essex Street and Newman Street. A computer inquiry revealed two warrants for his arrest out of the Hackensack Municipal Court and South Hackensack Municipal Court. Defendant remanded to Bergen County Jail in lieu of bail.
- **8/30/2023 Warrant Arrest, 8:21 PM (Main Street):** An officer observed the suspect panhandling in front of a business on Main Street. The suspect was stopped and found to have a warrant for her arrest out of the City of Paterson. She was arrested, processed, and released on her own recognizance by Paterson PD.
