Weekly Police Blotter

9/3/23-9/9/23

- **9/4/2023 Car Jacking, 9:47 AM (First Street):** The victim was seated in his car in a parking lot on First Street. He was approached by the suspect who stated to him that his car had a flat tire. When the victim got out to inspect his vehicle the suspect entered the vehicle and drove off. The victim attempted to intercede and was subsequently dragged behind the vehicle causing minor injury. An investigation was conducted by city detectives. The suspect was located and arrested. The vehicle was also recovered. The suspect was charged with first degree carjacking and with theft.
- **9/4/2023 Theft, 05:55 AM (South River Street):** The complainant, an employee of a gas station of South River Street, reported that the suspect pulled up to the pump and requested gas offering a \$100 bill for payment. The employee stated gas purchases must be exact change after certain hours. He further stated that the suspect pointed to his own waist and stated "I need Gas". The complainant stated this made him believe the suspect was in possession of a weapon, although no weapon of any kind was displayed or mentioned and no threats were made by the suspect. The victim filled the suspect's vehicle with gas and the suspect left without paying. The incident is under investigation.
- **9/4/2023 Shoplifting, 11:12 AM (Hackensack Avenue):** The suspect entered a hardware store located on Hackensack Avenue. He attempted to steal merchandise by walking past the point of sale without paying. He was detained by store security and was then arrested by responding officers for shoplifting.
- **9/6/2023 Warrant Arrest, 07:05 AM (Hudson Street):** An officer conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Hudson Street. During the stop, it was revealed that the vehicle registration was expired and the driver had an outstanding warrant out of Teaneck Municipal Court. The driver was arrested and processed. Teaneck Police Department responded and took custody of the driver.
- **9/6/2023 Warrant Arrest, 10:55 PM (Hudson Street):** Officers responded to a dispute on Hudson Street. Upon further investigation, one of the parties involved in the dispute had a warrant for his arrest out of River Edge. Suspect was arrested, processed, and turned over to River Edge Police.
