Weekly Police Blotter

10/1/23-10/7/23

- **10/1/2023 Motor Vehicle Theft, 10:54 AM (Prospect Avenue):** The victim reported that an unknown actor stole her vehicle from the south side parking lot of an apartment building on Prospect Avenue. The incident was captured on video surveillance and will be available for evidence purposes at a later date. The incident is under investigation.
- **10/1/2023 Recovered Stolen Vehicle, 11:41 AM (Hudson Street):** Officers responded to Hudson Street on a report of a blocked driveway. After further investigation, it was determined that the vehicle was confirmed stolen out of Wayne, NJ. Wayne PD was notified and the vehicle was impounded.
- **10/2/2023 Shoplifting, 4:30 PM (Main Street):** Loss prevention at a local retail store on Main Street stopped a suspect who had numerous items in a shopping cart and was attempting to leave the store with the unpaid merchandise. The suspect was arrested, processed, and released on a summons.
- **10/3/2023 Theft, 6:13 PM (Broadway):** A victim reported that packages were stolen from his front stoop. The incident was captured on his doorbell camera. The incident is under investigation.
- **10/4/2023 Driving While Intoxicated, 11:17 PM (Anderson Street):** A suspect was observed operating a vehicle and striking a wall and window of a structure. Officers responded and conducted field sobriety tests on the driver. It was determined that she was driving while intoxicated. She was arrested, processed, and released on multiple summonses.
- **10/4/2023 Warrant Arrest, 10:47 AM (Lehigh Street):** While patrolling the area of Lehigh Street, city detectives observed a party who they knew was wanted for multiple warrants. The party was stopped and the warrants were confirmed. He was arrested, processed, and released on his own recognizance.
- **10/4/2023 Warrant Arrest, 11:57 AM (Hudson Street):** While patrolling the area of Hudson Street, a city detective conducted a motor vehicle stop. It was determined during the stop that the driver had an outstanding warrant from Hackensack Municipal Court. The driver was arrested, processed, and released after posting bail.
