Weekly Police Blotter

9/10/23-9/16/23

- **9/11/2023 Burglary, 4:36 AM (Anderson Street):** Officers responded to an alarm at a convenience store located on Anderson Street. Video surveillance shows the suspect breaking the front door glass with an object. The suspect exited the business with the cash register. The incident is under investigation.
- **9/11/2023 Burglary, 11:28 AM (Prospect Avenue):** Complainant stated that several suspects were observed on video, gaining entry to the lobby area of a residential building on Prospect Avenue and leaving with approximately 20 packages. The incident is currently under investigation.
- **9/12/2023 Arson, 09:02 AM (Berkshire Place):** The suspect threw miscellaneous items into a dumpster along with 2 bags of charcoal brickettes and lit them on fire. Hackensack Fire Department extinguished the fire before any damage could occur. The incident is under investigation.
- **9/13/2023 Robbery, 2:55 PM (Moore Street):** A victim responded to police headquarters and reported that he had been robbed at gun point on Moore Street. The victim stated that suspects jumped out of a vehicle and asked him for gas money. They then offered the victim a gold ring as an exchange for cash. When the victim pulled out his wallet, one of the suspected pulled out a firearm. The suspects threw the victim's wallet back at him and then fled the area. This incident is under investigation.
- **9/14/2023 Warrant Arrest/Resisting Arrest, 10:52 AM (Prospect Avenue):** An officer initiated a motor vehicle stop at the intersection of Prospect Avenue & Beech Street. During the course of the officer's investigation, the driver bailed out the vehicle and fled south on Prospect Avenue, east on Atlantic Street and proceeded to jump a fence in the rear yard of a home on Atlantic Street. The driver was apprehended. He was charged with resisting arrest and was wanted for numerous active warrants.
