Weekly Police Blotter

- **9/17/2023 Vehicle Burglaries, 9:35 AM (Berry Street/DeWolf Place):** Multiple vehicles were burglarized during the overnight hours in the area of Berry Street and DeWolf Place. Some of the vehicle owners stated that the vehicles were locked, others were not sure. There are several cameras in the areas in which the burglaries took place. These incidents are under investigation.
- **9/18/2023 Theft of Catalytic Converter, 08:00 AM (Newman Street):** Victim reported that he parked his vehicle in the lot of a housing complex on Newman Street on 9/17/2023. He further reported that the catalytic converter of his vehicle was stolen during the overnight hours. This incident is under investigation.
- **9/18/2023 Theft of Vehicle, 09:15 AM (Park Street):** The victim reported parking their vehicle on Park Street on 9/17/2023. It was reported that the vehicle was left unlocked with the keys in the ignition. When the victim responded to retrieve their vehicle, they realized that the vehicle had been stolen. This incident is under investigation.
- **9/18/2023 Warrant Arrest, 6:35 PM (Main Street):** Officers responded to a report of an unwanted person on Main Street. After further investigation, the unwanted person was located and had an active warrant out of Garfield Municipal Court. He was arrested on the warrant and released on his own recognizance from police headquarters.
- **9/20/2023 Vehicle Burglary, 1:33 PM (Euclid Avenue):** The complainant reported that while her vehicle was parked in front of her residence on Euclid Avenue, it was burglarized during the overnight hours. The incident is under investigation.
- **9/21/2023 Shoplifting, 10:14 AM (Main Street):** The complainant, who is the loss prevention officer for a retail store on Main Street, reported that the defendant attempted to shoplift merchandise from the business when they were detained by store employees. The defendant was arrested and charged accordingly.
- **9/21/2023 Driving While Intoxicated, 7:49 PM (Summit Avenue):** Officers responded to a motor vehicle crash on Summit Avenue involving a vehicle that was overturned due to a collision. Upon further investigation, it was determined that one of the drivers was driving while intoxicated. They were arrested and charged accordingly.
