Weekly Police Blotter

9/24/23-9/30/23

- **9/25/2023 Vehicle Burglary, 10:15 AM (Summit Avenue):** The victim reported that he reviewed the video surveillance of his home on Summit Avenue and noticed that a suspect entered his vehicle and stole \$60 in cash. The incident is under investigation.
- **9/25/2023 Recovered Stolen Auto, 2:55 PM (Anderson Street):** A stolen vehicle was located on Anderson Street with its windows smashed and ignition popped out. The vehicle was impounded.
- **9/27/2023 Theft, 6:00 PM (Clay Street):** A victim reported that an unknown suspect stole a package that was delivered to her home on Clay Street. The incident is under investigation.
- **9/28/2023 Theft of Auto, 10:41 AM (Moore Street):** A victim reported parking their vehicle on Moore Street for a number of days. When they returned to their vehicle, they noticed that the vehicle was missing. The incident is under investigation.
- **9/28/2023 Shoplifting 1:30 PM (Main Street):** Loss prevention of a retail store on Main Street observed a suspect attempt to leave the store with \$355 in unpaid merchandise. The suspect was taken into custody by Loss Prevention and turned over to responding officers. He was arrested and charged.
- **9/28/2023 Theft 7:12 PM (Polifly Road):** The victim stated that she had a package delivered to her apartment building located on Polifly Road. When she responded to the mail area to retrieve her package, she found that it had been stolen. The incident is under investigation.
- **9/30/2023 Recovered Stolen Auto/Warrant Arrest, 1:37 AM (Main Street):** While conducting random checks of vehicles parked on Main Street, an officer checked one of the vehicles and the vehicle registration came back as not on file. After further investigation by the officer, it was determined that the vehicle had been stolen and was possibly being used for criminal activity. During the course of the investigation, a person approached officers with knowledge about the vehicle. She was attempting to retrieve items from the vehicle. A warrant check revealed that she had active warrants for her arrest. She was arrested and released after posting bail.
