**Weekly Police Blotter**

10/22/23-10/28/23

- **10/23/2023 Obstruction of a Governmental Function, 7:07 AM (Main Street):** Officers responded to Main Street on a report of a dispute and located the suspect. The report was for a fight and items breaking inside of an apartment. The suspect refused to allow officers to check the apartment for any injured victims and physically stood in the way. He was arrested and charged.
- **10/23/2023 Shoplifting, 6:56 PM (Main Street):** The complainant (Loss prevention) at a retail store on Main Street reported that the suspects placed numerous items in their shopping carts and attempted to leave the store without paying by walking past the point of sale. The suspects fled and entered a vehicle after being approached by security. The incident is under investigation.
- **10/25/2023 Motor Vehicle Burglary, 04:16 AM (East Kennedy Street):** Owner of a Trucking company on East Kennedy Street reported that an unknown male party was observed via video surveillance breaking the windows of five (5) dump trucks that were secured in a locked fenced in area of the property. Proceeds are five (5) EZ-Pass tags. Cost to replace the windows is approximately \$3,500.00. The incident is under investigation.
- **10/26/2023 Shoplifting, 3:38 PM (W. Pleasantview):** A suspect entered a supermarket located on West Pleasantview and concealed 11 cans of baby formula by having her infant child sit on the cans. She proceeded through the self-check lane without paying for any merchandise. She then went to customer service and paid for all the items in her cart except for the formula. She then left the store. The incident is under investigation.
- **10/27/2023 Aggravated Assault, 12:10 AM (Johnson Avenue):** Officers responded to a bar on Johnson Avenue on a report of a fight with a knife. Victim was located with a laceration to his chest and a knife was located. Victim was transported and received 4 staples to close the wound. A detective waited in the area of the suspect's residence and she arrived shortly thereafter. She was arrested and transported to headquarters for processing.
