**Weekly Police Blotter**

11/5/23-11/11/23

- **11/5/2023 Unlawful Possession of a Weapon, 11:05 PM (Newman Street):** Officers responded to a large group on Newman Street with a report that one person was possibly in possession of a handgun. Officers arrived on scene and observed several adults and juveniles walking away. Upon further investigation, a search was conducted on a juvenile suspect revealing a .22 caliber revolver, marijuana and alcohol in his possession. The juvenile was taken into custody and charged.
- **11/6/2023 Driving While Intoxicated, 12:59 AM (Campbell Avenue):** Officers responded to Campbell Avenue on a report of a motor vehicle crash. Upon further investigation, it was determined that one of the drivers was driving while intoxicated. The driver was arrested and charged.
- **11/6/2023 Shoplifting, 1:25 PM (South River Street):** A hardware store located on South River Street reported that a suspect concealed approximately \$1,105 worth of merchandise and exited the store without paying. The incident is under investigation.
- **11/6/2023 Robbery, 3:47 PM (Hackensack Avenue):** The actor was observed by security concealing various items worth \$338.31 at a hardware store located on Hackensack Avenue. After being stopped, she fled from security on foot, and in the process, sprayed an employee with oleoresin capsicum. The actor was arrested and charged.
- **11/7/2023 Motor Vehicle Theft, 6:15 PM (Campbell Avenue):** On November 7, 2023, members of the Hackensack Police Department responded to Campbell Avenue on a report of a motor vehicle theft. The victim reported that his vehicle was parked and running in the driveway when two (2) unknown suspects entered the vehicle and drove away. The victim later discovered the vehicle on the corner of Ackerson Street and Fair Street. The incident is under investigation.
- **11/11/2023 Robbery, 8:13 PM (Main Street):** Officers responded to a retail store on Main Street on a report of a robbery. The complainant reported that three suspects entered the store and each proceeded to load a shopping bag with random items. As the complainant confronted one of the suspects, the suspect pushed him and exited the store. All three suspects entered a vehicle and fled the area. The estimated proceeds were suspected to be approximately \$900.00. The incident is under investigation.
